New! End of Year Collaboration Award

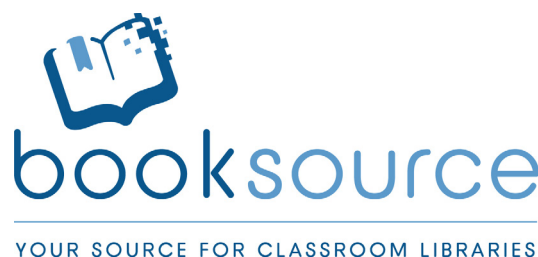
